

Remy Raglan Top

Date: Saturday, May 6th, 10:00am to 4:00pm

A simple raglan style top with multiple styles – long, short or ¾ sleeve. Add a button tab at the neck or not. Sizes to fit everyone. The raglan style is very forgiving. It eliminates the need to set in a sleeve and guarantees fit. Use French seams or serge if you want to decorate with stitches from sewing machine. The sample at SNS is size #12 with ¾ sleeve. The pattern length is flattering, however, I have added 3″ length in the sample. The fabric in the sample is scrap from some old polyester curtains. Feel free to try it on, as a rule, I put an invisible zipper in the side seam to make it easy to pull a longer top on and off. However, I will remake this in better fabric, it only took a day to make. The pattern is readily adaptable for knits, button front top or sweatshirt jacket and is worth the price. - 2 yards pattern tracer
- Polyester thread
- · Button if needed
- Basic sewing gear including good fabric shears
- Sewing machine in good working order, power cord and foot control
