Join your quilting buddies for whirlwind evening of sewing, eating and fun. Arrive at 6pm with your (minimal) homework completed and be ready to sew to your heart's content. We'll take a break for dinner to keep your strength up and then return to the sewing tables for as long as you can stand it (as long as you tire yourself out by midnight).

Supplies for quilt:

2 matching charm packs
1.25 yard background fabric

This makes a 44 x 52 inch quilt without borders.
If you want to make it larger get 4 matching charm packs and 2.25 yards of background. This will make a quilt about 58 x 72 without borders.

You will need all your regular sewing supplies for the class.

Sewing machine, cord, pedal
Thread
8 inch or larger square ruler
Rotary cutter
Pressing mat, iron if you want
Tool for pressing seams open if you have/use one

Homework:

From background fabric:
Cut 6 – 2.5 inch strips and subcut into 42- 2.5x5 inch rectangles
Cut 5 – 4.25 inch strips and subcut into 42- 4.25 inch squares
