Using floral and leaf fabrics, cut, glued and stitched you will create your own landscape design! I'll have a little "show and tell" of some of my landscape pieces for inspiration as well as your own pictures. I will show you different ways to approach your stitching. Always a fun class.

Supply list:

Pictures of inspiration to play off of.

If you're a true beginner at this, keep your piece relatively small. Think in the range of 12'-15" / 15"-18"

floral and leaf fabrics of your choice. Go for color as well as design.

If you find fabric that is directional, 1/2 yds.

Otherwise, fat quarters and scraps work well.

1/2 yd background fabric

fabric glue. I prefer to use Roxannes glue baste

Thread: I use invisible thread to stitch the motifs as well as color to enhance.

1/2 yd tear away stabilizer

machine, manual and all attachments.

free motion/darning foot

small sharp scissors

Fusible web. My choice and what I strongly recommend is Steam a Seam II lite.
