Supply list

2 focus fabrics for large squares – ½ yard each

2 contrasting fabrics for small squares – 1/4 yard each

1 fabric for center of striped rectangles – ½ yard

1 fabric for sides of striped rectangles – 1 yard

Sewing machine, power cord, pedal Regular sewing supplies, thread Cutting mat, rotary cutter

This makes a lap sized quilt 42.5 x 57.5 inches (without border). Consider buying extra fabric for border(s) from chosen fabric if desired.

Homework

From both focus fabrics-

Cut 3 - 5 inch strips x width of fabric Sub-cut each into 5 inch squares You need 24 squares of each fabric

From both contrasting fabrics-Cut 2 – 3 ½ inch strips x width of fabric Sub-cut each into 3 ½ inch squares You need 18 squares of each fabric

From center rectangle fabric cut 8-2 inch strips by width of fabric

From side rectangle fabric cut 16 - 2 inch strips by width of fabric
