

## Supply list

- 2 focus fabrics for large squares –  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard each
- 2 contrasting fabrics for small squares –  $\frac{1}{4}$  yard each
- 1 fabric for center of striped rectangles –  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard
- 1 fabric for sides of striped rectangles – 1 yard

Sewing machine, power cord, pedal  
Regular sewing supplies, thread  
Cutting mat, rotary cutter

This makes a lap sized quilt 42.5 x 57.5 inches (without border). Consider buying extra fabric for border(s) from chosen fabric if desired.

## Homework

From both focus fabrics-

- Cut 3 - 5 inch strips x width of fabric
- Sub-cut each into 5 inch squares
- You need 24 squares of each fabric

From both contrasting fabrics-

- Cut 2 – 3  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch strips x width of fabric
- Sub-cut each into 3  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch squares
- You need 18 squares of each fabric

From center rectangle fabric cut 8 – 2 inch strips by width of fabric

From side rectangle fabric cut 16 – 2 inch strips by width of fabric
